Citation.

1. These By-Laws may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Regulation of Traffic on Dams) By-Laws.

Use of dams without permission an offence. 2. Any person who uses any motor vehicle or hauls any log, timber, wood, padi, rice or any other agricultural products or plants by any means whatever on any dam without the permission in writing of the Drainage and Irrigation Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") or of any person authorised in that behalf by the

Board shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars.
